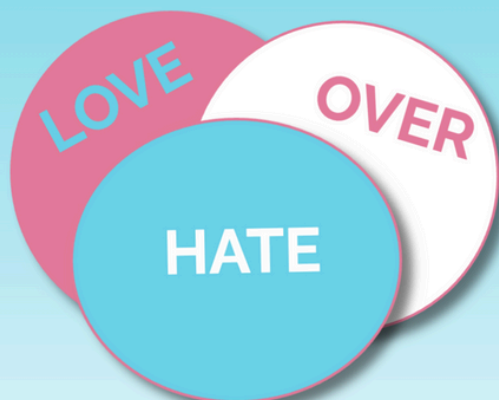


CELEBRATING VETERANS DAY

We honor and remember transgender individuals worldwide whose lives were tragically taken due to anti-transgender violence.

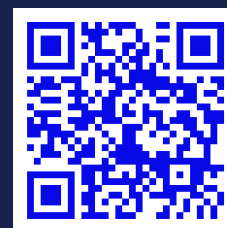
